TEAM

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- The tournament is a mixed competition.
- A team consists of up to 16 players; 8 on the field, up to 6 subs and 2 non-playing reserves. The makeup of players on the field is four females and four males.
- Two separate single gender schools are able to combine to make a combined mixed team. If no match can be found, inclusion of single gender schools will be at tournament organizer's discretion.
- A MAXIMUM of two teams per school are able to register.

PLAYERS: REGISTERED players ONLY are to play in the tournament. A maximum of up to 16 players can be registered (14 players and 2 non-playing reserves).

ELIGIBILITY: The tournament is open to all age groups at secondary school level. Each player must attend/be a current student of the respective school/schools it is registered for.

ASSEMBLY: Teams must be present at their field 2 minutes before kickoff.

TIME KEEPER: A siren will be sounded to start and finish the game and each quarter.
